Dear Sir,

I am writing to inform you, in relation to your liability to call-up for national service, that you are required, in accordance with the provisions of the National Service Act, to submit yourself to medical examination before a Medical Board.

You are therefore required to attend for this purpose  
at District Employment Office, 57 Market Street, Wollongong  
at 2.30 p.m. on the (Thursday) 7th day of March, 1968.

At the same time you will be interviewed with regard to your suitability for the various postings in the Army and other matters concerning national service. Would you, therefore, please bring with you any documents you have, such as certificates etc., relating to your educational or occupational qualifications.

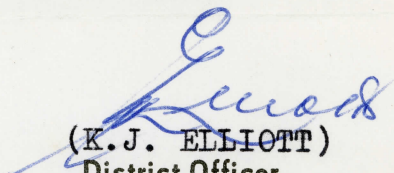
You should also bring this letter and your Certificate of Registration, and your marriage certificate if you are married. If you wear glasses be sure to have them with you.

Please be punctual so as to avoid inconvenience not only to yourself but also to others who will be attending at the same time.

If, because of illness or other quite unavoidable circumstances, you should be unable to attend at the time stated, or if you will be temporarily absent from the district and it would be more convenient to arrange for an examination elsewhere, please advise me immediately so that other arrangements can be made. It is in your own interests to do so, because failure to comply with this notice or to submit to medical examination is an offence under the National Service Act.

After the examination the Registrar for National Service will advise you in writing whether or not you will be called up for service.
